Title:	Dengue cases spread to other parts of East Singhbhum, Jharkhand

The dengue cases in East Singhbhum are now being reported from other parts of Jamshedpur. The district health department has identified 17 positive cases in Govindpur, a suburban area in the peripheral of the city. Besides, seven cases have been reported from Chakulia in the last 24 hours.

The district surveillance officer, Dr Md Asad, has said that a special health camp was organised in Govindpur on Sunday, where health check up of the local people was conducted. The camp will continue for the next few days.

Asad said over 12 fresh cases of high fever have been identified in Govindpur and samples have been sent to the microbiology department of Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Medical College and Hospital (MGMMCH) for testing.

The health team of the community health centre (CHC) in Chakulia is looking into the dengue cases, besides, the surveillance department is facilitating the team in conducting the testing. Anti-larval activity is also being carried out in the affected areas, and, the municipal bodies at Govindpur and Chakulia are conducting the cleaning drive.

Asad has said that 92 cases of dengue have been reported in the district so far this year and the total number includes 74 dengue cases reported between July and August 5.

The official said that dengue cases are being reported in less number in the command area of Tata Steel in comparison to the other parts of the urban circle. Not ruling out the possibility of increase in dengue cases in the coming days, the surveillance officer said that the district is perennial to dengue cases with the start of the monsoon rains.
