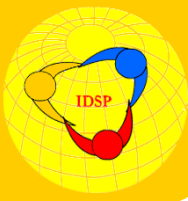

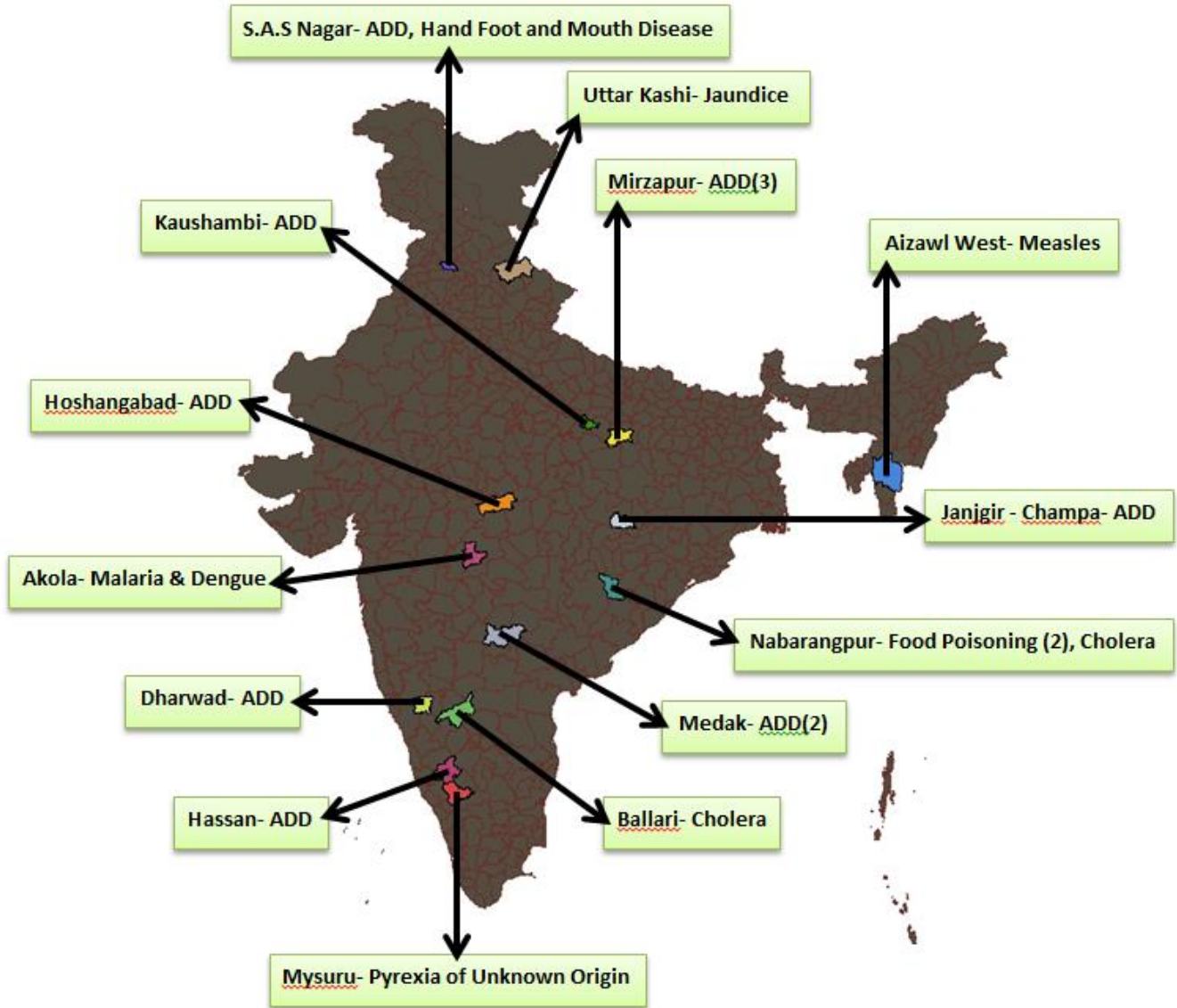

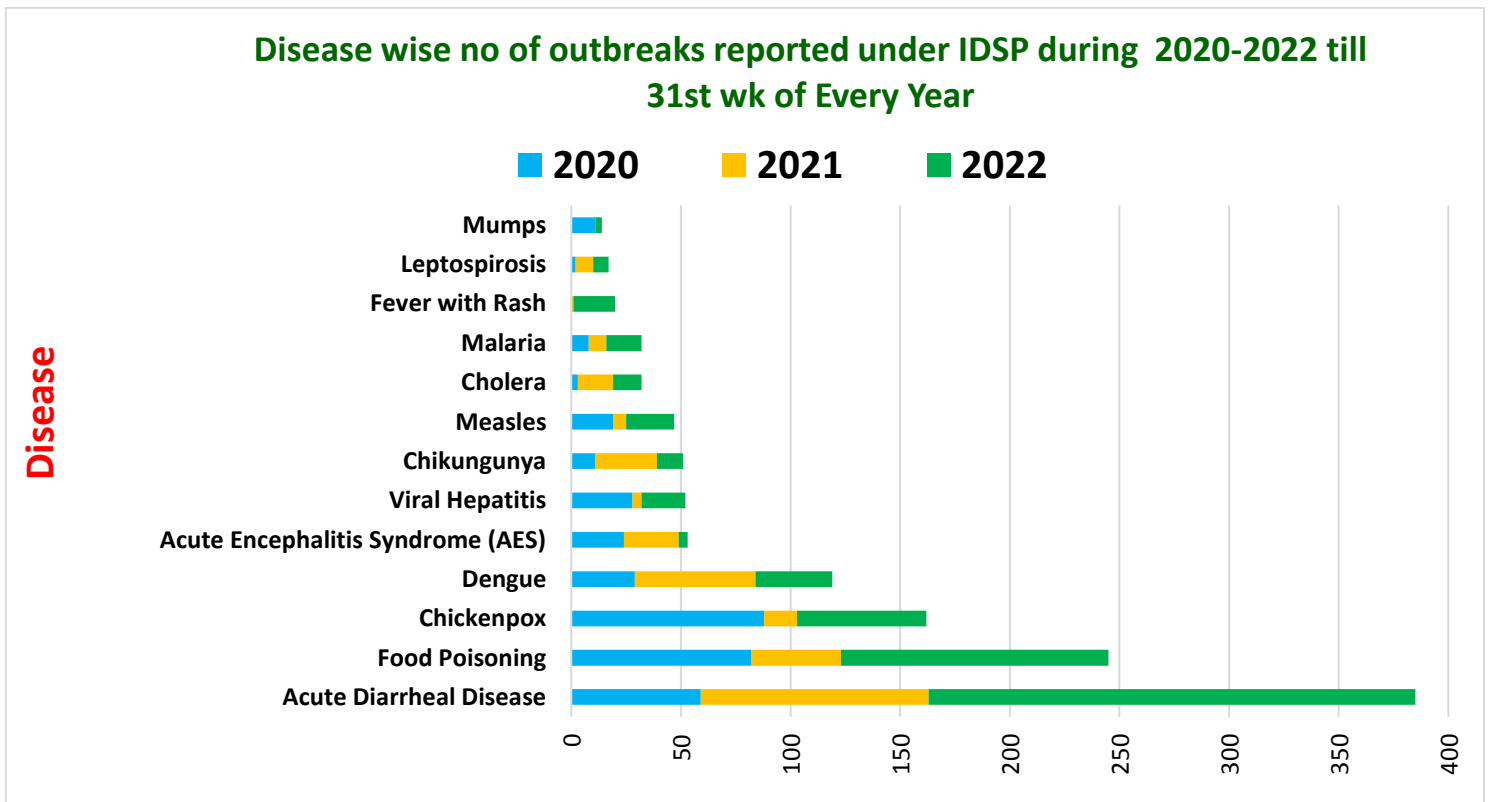
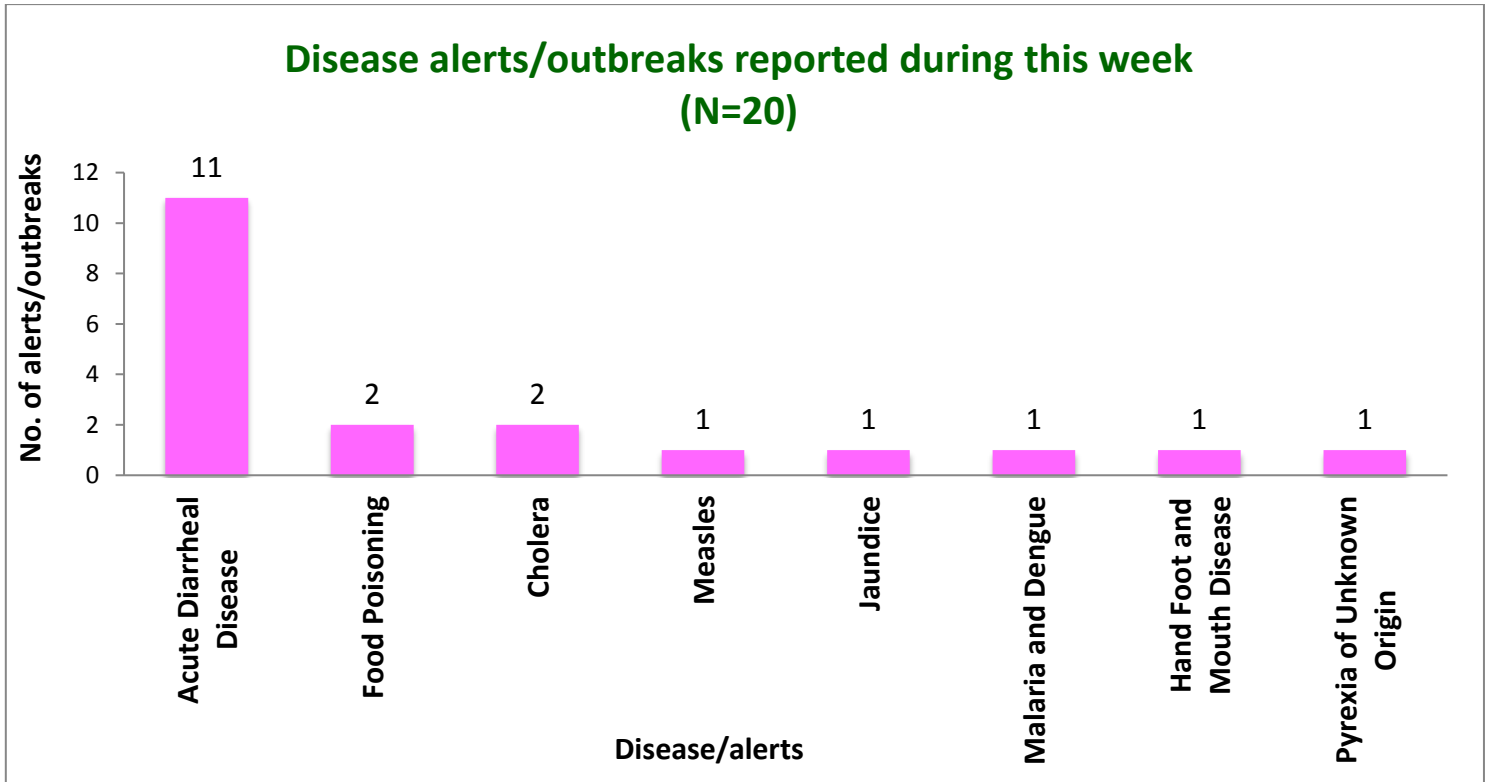

Cases presented with loose stools and abdominal pain. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house active case finding was done. Halogen tablets and ORS sachets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene and intake of safe drinking water.
KN/BEL/2022/31/607	Karnataka	Ballari	Cholera	147	00	05-08-22	05-08-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Malapur Village, Bandri PHC, Sandur Taluk. Cases presented with fever, loose stools and vomiting. Five stool samples were sent to VIMS Ballari. Seven water, 15 blood and four stool samples were sent to DPHL, Ballari for culture and sensitivity. Of these, two were found positive for Vibrio cholerae. Out of the water samples, three were found not suitable for potable purpose. None of the blood samples showed growth of any pathogenic organism. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey was done. Halogen tablets and ORS sachets were distributed in the affected houses. Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water, hand washing practices and sanitation measures.

Cases presented with vomiting, loose stools and abdominal pain. Three water samples were sent for lab analysis and were found not suitable for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey was done. Halogen tablets and ORS sachets were distributed in the affected houses. Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water, consumption of fresh and hot food, hand washing practices and sanitation measures.

Cases presented with vomiting and abdominal pain following consumption of non-vegetarian dish that was prepared in the hostel. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene and intake of safe drinking water with special emphasis on hygiene of food handlers and food handling techniques.

Cases presented with fever, cold and cough. Most of the cases were males who belonged to the age group of 41-60 years. 20 blood samples were sent to VRDL, MMCRI, Mysuru and two samples were sent to DSL, Mysuru. All of them were found negative for COVID-19 and Dengue. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house fever survey was done in the area. Health education was given.

Cases presented with fever with chills and bodyache. 27 blood smears were collected and sent to GMC Akola. Out of these, four were found positive for Plasmodium vivax. Five blood samples were sent to GMC Akola and of these, one was found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to House surveillance activity was done. Health education was given regarding the importance of vector control measures.

Five samples were sent to Guwahati Medical College, Assam. Of these, three samples were found positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases were isolated. Frequent changes of bedding and personal belongings done, adequate diet and plenty of fluids were emphasized. Vitamin A Prophylaxis was given. Health education was imparted regarding importance of personal hygiene.
OR/NAB/2022/31/613	Odisha	Nabarangpur	Food Poisoning	122	00	31-07-22	01-08-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Jamarunda UV 13 and Podeiguda, SC Tilondi, PHC Badabharandi, Block Umerkote, District Nabarangpur. Cases presented with vomiting and loose stools. Two rectal and two water samples were sent to DPHL Nabarangapur. Of these, one stool sample showed presence of Salmonella typhi and one water sample was found not suitable for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak and house to house survey was conducted. All cases were given symptomatic treatment. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.

Of the three rectal swab samples, two were found positive for Vibrio cholerae and one water sample was found unsafe for drinking water. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey was done. Halogen tablets and ORS sachets were distributed in the affected houses. Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water, consumption of fresh and hot food, hand washing practices and sanitation measures.

Two rectal swab samples showed presence of Shigella and all the water samples were found not suitable for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak and house to house survey was conducted. All cases were given symptomatic treatment. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.

Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water, consumption of fresh and hot food, hand washing practices and sanitation measures.

They were not tested for Hepatitis B and C. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house active case finding was done. Halogen tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene and intake of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with loose stools. Six stool and three water samples were sent to Regional Lab Swasthya Bhawan, Lucknow. None of the stool samples showed growth of Enteropathogenic organism. Out of three water samples, one was found non potable. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house active case finding was done. Halogen tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene and intake of safe drinking water.

Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water, consumption of fresh and hot food, hand washing practices and sanitation measures.

Health education was given regarding its preventive measures.

House to house active case finding was done. Halogen tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene and intake of safe drinking water.
