Two women in Appapara village, falling under this district, have been inflicted with Monkey fever, also known as Kyasanur Forest Disease (KFD), Health authorities confirmed here on Tuesday.

They said the two are under medical observation. District Medical Officer R Renuka urged the people to remain cautious. Monkey fever is a tick-borne viral haemorrhagic fever, endemic to South India. The disease is caused by a virus belonging to the family Flaviviridae, which also includes yellow fever and dengue fever, which are transmitted by monkeys
