<b>Title:</b>	<b>19 people sick due to vomiting &amp; dysentery in Yadgir district, Karnataka</b>

Vomiting and dysentery cases were reported in Gajrakota village of Gurmatkal taluk of the district on Monday and 19 people fell ill by Tuesday afternoon. Health Officer of Gazarkota Primary Health Center Dr. M.M. Rahil said, "Total 19 cases have been found so far, only 8 people have vomiting and diarrhea problem. Rest of them have stomach pain, fever, typhoid fever. They have also been admitted to hospital and have recovered. The problem is due to contaminated water. Our staff collected water samples and checked whether the water is safe to drink. Then it will be brought to people's attention," he said.

Taluk Medical Officer Dr. Manmantareddy said, "Five people have been sent to Gurumathkal Community Health Center and have received medical attention and have recovered. One of the elderly has developed low blood pressure and has been sent to Yadgiri District Hospital. Five people are currently receiving medical attention at the primary health center of the village and 2 people have recovered and returned home. Vomiting occurred in Shivpur and Gajrakota villages due to consumption of contaminated water. "The Bedhi case has escalated. We are treating it. There is no danger to life," he said.
