Poultry farmers in Tamil Nadu, particularly these within the Namakkal district, have taken precautions after the outbreak of chook flu in Kerala. The livestock division of Kerala introduced on Monday that 1000's of geese within the districts of Alappuzha, Kottayam and Pathanamthitta died of chook flu. Though there is no such thing as a outbreak of chook flu in Tamil Nadu, poultry farmers all through the state have taken precautions. "We vaccinate the chicks with out fail. However within the wake of the outbreak of chook flu in Kerala, we've got tightened biosafety on all farms, "stated P Nallathambi, president of the Tamil Nadu Poultry Farmers Affiliation.

Based on the biosafety methodology, all individuals engaged on poultry farms should put on separate clothes and be sprayed with a medication (a combination of an antiviral drugs and salt). Equally, individuals coming from different locations for enterprise functions ought to wash their fingers and legs within the drugs earlier than coming into the farms.
