A middle-aged woman died of H1N1 in Wayanad. Ayesha (48), a native of Thalapuzha, died at her Nallakandi house. Ayesha was diagnosed with H1N1 on June 30. He was being treated at the Medical College Hospital due to high fever. He died last night.

This is the third fever death to be reported in Wayanad district recently. Earlier, two children had died due to fever. In the case of the death of two children within a week, an expert team visited the district and conducted an inspection. Dr. Asma Rahim, Head of Community Medicine, Kozhikode Medical College, conducted the inspection in two teams in the affected areas of the district.

The team that visited the colony of four-year-old girl Rudra, who died of fever, responded that there were many favorable factors for the spread of diseases in the area. The team visited Batheri Marod Chavanan Colony and collected drinking water samples. A visit was also made to Kampalakkad, Kanyampata and Begur where the number of cases of disease has been reported. The report of the expert committee will be forwarded to the health department.
