At least 15 monkeys were found dead on the roadside in Bandaru village of Uppinangady forest range.

Puttur sub division ACF Subrahmanya Rao told TOI that experts have visited the spot. Preliminary investigation has ruled out Kyasanur Forest Disease (KFD) or monkey fever. Instead, poisoning is suspected. Veterinarians have collected the samples and based on their report, expected to come on Saturday, an inquiry will be conducted, he said.

Many suspect that poison have been given to monkeys to get rid of them and save plantations.
